

QUICK REFERENCE GUIDE

Has tested positive for COVID-19

with COVID-19

Lives with someone who is sick with COVID-19 symptoms

Had close contact (within six feet for at least 15 minutes) with an individual who has confirmed or suspected COVID-19

COVID-19 **SYMPTOMS**



- Fever of 100 or higher
- Chills
- Cough
- Shortness of breath or difficulty breathing
- Sore throat
- Muscle or body aches
- Loss of taste or smell
- Headache
- Fatigue
- Congestion or runny nose
- Nausea or vomiting
- Diarrhea

If an individual has any of these symptoms, please do not attend school and refer to the chart on the right for further guidance.

Is sick symptoms of

INDIVIDUAL MAY RETURN TO CAMPUS



Once 10 days have passed since symptom onset and 24 hours without fever, without fever-reducing medication, and symptoms have substantially reduced.

IF ASYMPTOMATIC:

Once 10 days from date of positive test.

Once individual submits a negative COVID-19 test result to the school nurse. The test must have been taken after symptoms began.

OR

Once 10 days pass since symptom onset and 24 hours without fever without fever-reducing medication and substantial improvement of symptoms.

OR

If experiencing COVID-19 symptoms may only return with a doctor's note stating patient is not contagious and may return to school.

Once the household member tests negative for COVID-19 and after the exposed individual completes a 14-day quarantine.

This 14-day quarantine period begins on the date that the symptoms started and isolation from the person begins.

After completing a 14-day quarantine, after the last exposure to the individual.
