1. Summer Solutions Workbooks (Rising K5-5<sup>th</sup> grade)

If you did not receive one, we recommend you order *at least* the **math** and the **reading** workbook. But there are other options, as well.

Bring each workbook you complete to your teacher in the fall, and you can choose between either a HW pass or an Out of Uniform pass for each one as well as receive a certificate of completion.
